Regular Meeting

February 7, 2017

The Lowry City Council Meeting was called to order on February 7, 2017, at 7:00 pm by Mayor Dan Sutton with the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES: From the January 3 regular council meeting were posted and reviewed. There being no corrections or additions, motion by Iris, second by Shelley that these minutes be approved. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: With the January activities was reviewed by all council members. There being no corrections or additions, motion by Virgil, second by Iris that these be accepted and filed. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

VISITOR'S COMMENTS: Dennis Jones informed the City Council that a bid had been awarded for adding onto St. Paul's church, and that the contractor would take care of requesting the building permit.

The City Garage is being renovated by the Fire Department to meet Fire Department needs.

John Vosberg requested a permit to do a raffle for the Sons of the American Legion. Shelley made the motion that we approve the permit. Iris seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: The City Council was given some color options for the water treatment facility. Between the Council members and Troy Drewes, a color option was chosen, and the facility will be a buff colored brick with dark green trim and doors, which was the #5 option given. Virgil made the motion that we choose the #5 option. Iris seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

The billing system is updated and ready to print out the new billing amounts for the next billing cycle.

NEW BUSINESS: The Lowry Firemen's Relief Association gave the City a donation. Shelley made the motion that we accept the donation and deposit it into the Fire Department Equipment account. Iris seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

Waste Management proposed a 3% increase to their billing. Iris made a motion that we accept the proposal as written. Virgil seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

The storm sewer on the corner of Aurora and Maple is not draining, and this has been an ongoing concern. After discussion, Lisa made a motion that we ask Lundblad's if they can look at the storm sewer on the corner of Aurora and Maple and repair it so it drains as expected. Shelley seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

OTHER ITEMS OF DISCUSSION:

BILLS: Motion by Iris, second by Shelley that all bills be paid. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.
