Regular Meeting

March 7, 2017

The Lowry City Council Meeting was called to order on March 17, 2017, at 7:00 pm by Mayor Dan Sutton with the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES: From the February regular council meeting were posted and reviewed. There being no corrections or additions, motion by Shelley, second by Virgil that these minutes be approved. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: With the February activities was reviewed by all council members. There being no corrections or additions, motion by Virgil, second by Iris that these be accepted and filed. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

VISITOR'S COMMENTS: Luke Allen presented documents in preparation for applying for a building permit for a house he's planning to build on Bryce Ave.

Luke Musselman approached the City Council regarding a plan to start a coffee shop in a building that would be positioned near Musselman Accounting. The coffee shop would be a drive through business. The building would not be permanent, so a building permit is not necessary. A peddler's permit would be required. Virgil made a motion that we approve the peddler's permit when that time comes. Iris seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: City Council members have been approached by members of the community regarding a garage fire that happened some time ago and the remains from the fire and refuse are blowing around, getting in other's yards, causing concerns. A letter will be sent to the homeowner requesting cleanup within 30 days.

NEW BUSINESS: We've had some nice weather and some residents have cleaned up their yards already. We talked about the City's summer hire position, and Brian Sutton has filled this position over the past four summers. He is willing to continue. Iris made a motion that we continue employing Brian Sutton as our summer hire position at \$15 per hour. Shelley seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

BILLS: Motion by Shelley, second by Virgil that all bills be paid. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

Next regular meeting will be April 4 at the Community Center at 7:00 p.m.

Adjourn: Motion by Iris, second by Virgil that we adjourn the meeting. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.
