

# Lowry City Council

## Regular Meeting

April 4, 2017

The Lowry City Council Meeting was called to order on April 4, 2017, at 7:00 pm by Mayor Dan Sutton with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Dan Sutton, Virgil Coziahr, Iris Scott, Shelley Svec, Lisa Anderson

**MEMBERS ABSENT:** None

**OTHERS PRESENT:** David Svec, Elvis Wood, Robert Hedline, Merl Farber

**MINUTES:** From the March regular council meeting were posted and reviewed. There being no corrections or additions, motion by Virgil, second by Iris that these minutes be approved. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** With the March activities was reviewed by all council members. There being no corrections or additions, motion by Shelley, second by Virgil that these be accepted and filed. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

**VISITOR'S COMMENTS:** David Svec informed the City Council that the Legion would like to install an approximately 12x16' walk-in cooler. The City Council asked for a drawing of the placement of the walk-in cooler when that's available.

The grass and ground at the ballpark has been tore up with ATV's. Please respect the ballpark, and do not ride ATV's on the grounds or grass. After discussion, the Council members agreed to purchase signs asking people not to ride ATV's in the park. Virgil made a motion that we purchase 4 signs asking people not to ride ATV's at the park. Lisa seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** Closing on the Peltier is postponed pending closing paperwork. No closing date has been set yet.

The request for the cleanup to the property following the fire has been suspended due to the homeowner's stating that the insurance company has asked them not to start cleanup. The City Council requested them to have the insurance company send a letter to the City for verification of that information. Elvis stated that they will keep the City informed of any progress.

**NEW BUSINESS:** An application for a building permit for the addition to St. Paul's Lutheran Church has been received. Drawings of the addition have also been received. Shelley made a motion that we approve Building Permit #1208 pending payment of the permit. Virgil seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

The City Council discussed the spring street sweeping. Iris made a motion that we scheduled the spring street sweeping. Shelley seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

Alley maintenance was discussed. Virgil made a motion that we should contact Lundblad Brother's Excavating and ask them to do the alley maintenance. Iris seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

The City's insurance policy is up for renewal. Along with the renewal is a Liability Coverage Waiver Form. Virgil made a motion that we do not waive the liability limits. Shelley seconded that motion. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.

**BILLS:** Motion by Shelley , second by Iris that all bills be paid. All voted Aye to approve. Motion carried.
