Ordinance No. 94
Peddlers, Solicitors, Transient Merchants

An Ordinance providing for the issuing of License/Permit for Peddlers, Solicitor & Transient Merchants in the City of Lowry

The City Council of the City of Lowry does ordain as follows:

1. No person shall conduct business as a peddler, solicitor or transient merchant within the city limits without first having obtained the appropriate license/permit from the city. Application for a city license to conduct business as a peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall be made at least 14 regular business days before the applicant desires to begin conducting business. Application for a license shall be made on a form approved by the City Council and available from the office of the City Clerk. All applications shall be signed by the applicant. Fee for this application will be set by the City Council.
2. License exemptions.
 1. No license shall be required for any person to sell or take orders for products grown, produced, cultivated or raised on any farm.
 2. No license shall be required for any person when the activity is for the purpose of exercising the rights of freedom of speech, press, religion and the like.
3. No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant, unless invited to do so by the property owner or tenant, shall enter the property of another for the purpose of conducting business as a peddler, solicitor or transient merchant when the property is marked with a sign or placard at least four inches long and four inches wide stating "No Peddlers, Solicitors or Transient Merchants" or "Peddlers, Solicitors and Transient Merchants Prohibited", or other comparable statement. No person other than the property owner or tenant shall remove, deface or otherwise tamper with any sign or placard under this section.
4. That this ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
