MN DOT 2023

Minnesota Department of Transportation has slated a sidewalk project for Highway 114. The project will begin in January 2023. This project will address sidewalk replacement, as well as curb and gutter issues from the Hwy 28 intersection all the way to Hwy 55. MN DOT has asked the city to provide a community "wish list" of items the community would like MN DOT to consider adding into the project for this stretch of road.
